ASSOCIATE: Completion of an undergraduate degree in geology or a related geoscience field from an accredited college or university

I: Completion of an undergraduate degree in geology or a related geoscience field from an accredited college or university AND One year of professional work experience.

2: Completion of an undergraduate degree in geology or a related geoscience field from an accredited college or university AND two years of related professional work.

Note: Completion of a masters degree in geology or related geoscience field from an accredited college or university may substitute for a maximum of one year of professional work related experience.
