### **PENN STATE SENIOR WINS METEOROLOGY AWARD**

**University Park, Pa.,** Mar. 22, 2004 -- Andrew Metcalf, a Penn State University senior and Schreyer Honors College scholar was awarded the Dr. Pedro Grau Undergraduate Scholarship by the American Meteorological Society.

Metcalf, the son of Donald and Martha Metcalf of Smithsburg, Md., will graduate with honors from the College of Earth and Mineral Sciences with a bachelor's degree in meteorology and a minor in mathematics. The topic of his honors thesis is "Understanding the Photochemical Product of Ozone in Urban Environments."

Metcalf is a member of the National Meteorological Honor Society, Chi Epsilon Pi, as well as the Penn State Branch of the American Meteorological Society.

His future goals are to attend graduate school in pursuit of a Ph.D. in atmospheric science.

The American Meteorological Society presents undergraduate scholarships to the nation's future meteorologists, oceanographers, hydrologists, and climatologists each year. The scholarships help to further the education of future scientists.
